VISION IMPAIRED EVENTS = A DSA registered Professional, Amateur or Recreational Division Competitor may partner any person holding a DSA Athletes License with a vision impairment.

PARA DANCE EVENTS = A DSA registered Professional, Amateur or Recreational Division Competitor may partner any person holding a DSA Athletes License with a physical impairment using a wheelchair.

TEAM EVENTS & SYNCHRO COUPLE EVENTS
